The Best Public Park Awards

Parks who have won their category in the previous two consecutive years may not enter in 2010.

This award is divided into three sections -

1. Recreation Grounds & Small Public Gardens (up to 5 acres)

Judging Time – a maximum of one hour to include 15 min for presentations & photos. (Include spring bedding and community involvement evidence where appropriate)

2. Parks & Large Public Gardens (from 5 acres and above).

Judging Time - a maximum of one & quarter hours to include 15 min for presentation & photos. (Include spring bedding and community involvement evidence where appropriate)

3. Country Parks

Judging Time - a maximum of one & half hours to include 15 min for presentation and photos (include evidence of community involvement)

4. Conservation Area – an area designated for conservation which does not conform to the other categories e.g. woodland, local nature reserve, area of conservation importance (Please check before entering this category)

Judging Time - a maximum of one & half hours to include 15 min for presentation and photos (include evidence of community involvement)
